# About the Bidjipidji School Program 2024

The Bidjipidji school program is a fully supervised, five-day program designed to provide First Nations students in years 9 and 10 (years 11 and 12 will be considered on a case-by-case basis) with an opportunity to experience university life at Charles Darwin University (CDU). The program is coordinated by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor First Nations Leadership & Engagement (DVC FNL&E) to promote and encourage positive post school pathways into further education.

During the 2024 Bidjipidji school program, students will be introduced to tertiary studies and meet fellow students from around Darwin. The Bidjipidji program aims to assist students in identifying their paths of interest and identifying the subject prerequisites required for further study in that field. The program will combine expertise from CDU faculties, First Nations Leadership portfolio and industries for an all-round comprehensive and unique experience. Bidjipidji aims to nurture the leadership, growth and development of all participants with a culturally relevant, fun and engaging program of activities.

A visit to CDU's Open Day is scheduled at our Casuarina Campus in Darwin on Saturday, 17th August. Here, participants will be exposed to the vast array of courses delivered by CDU including Technical and Further Education (TAFE) programs and Higher Education courses (bachelor degrees and post-graduate studies).

# Who can apply?

Any Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student who is in year 9 and 10 living in Darwin is eligible to apply.

## Cost

The program runs at no cost to the student. All meals, program expenses and excursions during the program days are provided by CDU.

#### **Dates and location**

The 2024 Bidjipidji school program will be held Saturday 17 August to Thursday 22 August, excluding Sunday. This program is based at CDU's Casuarina Campus in Darwin with excursions to other local sites and Campuses (eg. CDU Waterfront and Palmerston).

#### What's involved?

The program runs for five days and involves an extensive timetable including academic sessions, cultural activities, and excursions. All students who attend the program are required to fully participate in all activities set down in the program. This will involve group presentations, team activities and possibly public speaking – all in a fully supportive environment.


The days are completely full and as such, students are expected to arrive at the Casuarina Campus by 8:15 am. The day will conclude by 4 pm. Transport to and from CDU Casuarina Campus is the responsibility of the participant.

# Who else is involved in completing this Expression of Interest?

Students must tell us if they have the support of their families to submit this Expression of Interest. *Please tick if you have family support to apply.* 

There is also a section in this EOI that must be completed by a Referee, who recommends this student for the Program.

Bidjipidji is the Larrakia word for dragonfly, a totem representing illumination and enlightenment and is said to 'bring in the light', so you can 'see' better both physically and spiritually.



## **How to apply**

- 1. Discuss the EOI with your school teacher, principal and parents or carer first.
- Complete the fillable areas on the PDF EOI form and save,
   OR
   complete and printout the EOI form included in this PDF document and sign the declaration.
- Pass the completed document to your parents/ guardians to complete their section and the Talent Release Information.
- 4. Pass the completed document to your Referee and ask them to complete their section. (Your Referee could also be the person that helped you with the application.
- Return the completed application, preferably by email to CDU, before the closing date. (Contact details are on the last page of this document.)

## When to apply

EOIs for the Bidjipidji School Program open in May 2024 and close on the 12th July 2024.


## **Next Steps**

# Appendix A – Bidjipidji School Program Requirements

The guiding principles for what makes a Bidjipidji student are; one who shows potential for further education, who would benefit from tailored support getting to further education and who is willing and able to commit to the Program requirements below.

## **Bidjipidji Students**

A Bidjipidji student will have the following characteristics:

**WILLING** – are willing to have a go and who with support, can step outside of their comfort zone

**PASSION** – show some passion and drive to make a difference to themselves and their community

**CURIOUS –** are curious about life and learning and may see the value of further education

**POTENTIAL** – show potential for, or would benefit from continued education, including TAFE/University studies.

**RESPECT –** show respect for other students, CDU staff and the entire Bidjipidji team

**TEAM PLAYER –** are comfortable with being in a team and can demonstrate team player attributes

### **Eligibility**

To be part of the Bidjipidji program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a year 9 or 10 student in Darwin
- Be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Have good school attendance

#### Your commitment

- Participate in all parts of the Bidjipidji program
- Be prepared to imagine your future and set personal goals
- Participate at your school

#### 2. Progress

- Share your progress with us through school
- Attend school and demonstrate academic progress

#### 3. Communication

- Communicate with the Bidjipidji team post
   Program let us know of any changes including moving interstate/overseas or to another school
- Respond to Bidjipidji staff through email, phone calls and messages
- Reach out for help/advice when needed
- Complete surveys and evaluations and provide constructive feedback
